



here have been many films made based on video games, but as Jake Gyllenhaal, who plays the title role of Prince Dastan in *Prince of Persia: The Sands of Time*—based on the popular videogame series—recently told about.com, those films often try too hard to replicate the game, instead of making a great movie with a strong plot. "As filmmakers, we started with the idea of making a story that was fun and entertaining and not just saying, 'Is it going to look cool?' We wanted to tell a great story. That was our primary focus." Director Mike Newell (*Harry Potter And the Goblet Of Fire*) first came to the project not because of the action and effects, but because of the "immensely romantic" script.

But fear not, action fans. *Prince of Persia* is full of incredible visuals, spectacular effects and thrilling action. Gyllenhaal opted to do as many of his own stunts as he could. "I tried everything, but I didn't always succeed at everything," quipped Gyllenhaal to about.com. "So what I didn't succeed at, someone else had to pull off. It was difficult, but also really fun."

The film has an impressive supporting cast, including Ben Kingsley (*Shutter Island*) as the angry ruler and villain Nizam, the always-reliable Alfred Molina (*Spider-Man 2*) as Sheik Amar and the beautiful Gemma Arterton (*Clash Of The Titans, Quantum Of Solace*) as Princess Tamina. British star Arterton prepped for her part by spending time in Madrid training for her numerous horseback-riding scenes.


The story revolves around power and the possession of our most valuable commodity: time. The Sands of Time—a gift from the gods that can reverse time and allow its possessor to rule the world—is controlled by the evil Nizam as Dastan and Tamina join forces to defeat him.

Even though, like most popular video games, it has a tremendous following, Gyllenhaal didn't seem pressured or concerned about living up to fans' expectations and was purely interested with the depth of the character. "I was drawn to the role of Dastan because of his great sense of humor, and I loved the fact that he got to kick some butt," Gyllenhaal has said.

So how good is Gyllenhaal at playing the actual video game? "I did play the original game version when I was a kid," Gyllenhaal admitted. "For this role I picked up *The Sands of Time* version and it was pretty tough! I had a hard time with all of the levels. Maybe with a little more practice I can get better, but it was pretty cool!"




"I would say the ultimate New York woman is her own person," Parker says. "They can be any size, shape, color, ethnic background, political, ideological, and philosophically their own person... that's the beauty of New York. Nobody feels particularly responsible to be like anybody else."







own and her independent nature pushes her to do what Edward fears most.







BARBOSA: It was like going to Disneyland—I was ecstatic! I was like, "Wow, I can't believe I got this." I was still pinching myself on set. I was very lucky to be invited on this team.

What was your inspiration for the looks?

BARBOSA: Well, I knew the visuals were going to be amazing, and I knew we had to bring it to a different realm with the hair part of everything. So what we did was create some amazing styles; we actually took it up and took it down. It is just going to go through so many variations; it's going to be pretty amazing.

If you could describe each woman in one word, what would it be?

BARBOSA: Sarah Jessica Parker would be inspiration. She just inspires so many by being on the set every day. She is also a producer, so she helped us all out with that division. Kim: an amazing spirit. She just made you feel so comfortable and you could just hang out with her all day long. Cynthia, I would say knowledgeable. She's a smart woman, very smart. Kristin, I would say quirky. She made you laugh all the time!

Are any of them like the characters they play?

BARBOSA: Kristin is very much like her character. I have to say SJP is very stylish—whether it comes to interior design to what she's wearing to the make-up she puts on. Even when she comes in with big sunglasses and her hair in a ponytail, she always looks cute to me.

Tell me about the hair trends for spring?

BARBOSA: Everybody wanted waves this past year. In the past two years I've been working on films where everyone still wants the loose, Brigitte Bardot, wavy beautiful hair, and I think the sexier the better. I think



I've noticed a lot of headpieces and scarves from the trailer.

BARBOSA: Yeah, headpieces are back in—anything dramatic and beautiful with fashion and style. I'm hoping that the runways for fall and winter will show a lot more hats and headpieces. I'm a big fan of hats.

How did you create SJP's famous waves?




