





# Jenelly Demons

Murder, mystery and intrigue return as Tom Hanks reprises his role as symbologist Robert Langdon in the prequel that sparked Dan Brown's best-selling book *The Da Vinci Code*.





IRST of all, let's dispense with the big question. Yes, he got a haircut! Despite the massive success of Dan Brown's novel *The Da Vinci Code*, much of the chatter about the film had to do with Tom Hanks' hair—a sort-of nod to John Travolta's *Pulp Fiction* 'do.

But this time, (a smartly coifed) Hanks returns to his gig as symbologist Robert Langdon, asked by the Vatican to investigate a murder in which the victim is brutally branded by a secret 400-year-old society known as the Illuminati, the sworn enemy of the Catholic Church. Meanwhile, the Vatican is buzzing with the prospect of choosing a new pope, but other forces are conspiring—not only to destroy famous and sacred landmarks, but also to deal a permanent deathblow to the Church.

Although Brown's novel Angels & Demons is a prequel to The Da Vinci Code, director Ron Howard and producer Brian Grazer decided the movie would play as a sequel. They have also taken a few liberties, which they say will help the plot move a little faster.

But filming at historic Rome landmarks was nearly impossible. "This movie was, strangely, harder to shoot than The Da Vinci Code," producer Grazer recently told USA Today, "even though there's less controversy." The Church was less than impressed by the gruesome murders in the story, so the filmmakers were banned from almost all of the churches and Vatican locations; instead, spectacular replicas were constructed in L.A. However, Ron Howard has admitted that some genuine footage was shot in Rome. "We didn't shoot at the Vatican...officially. But cameras can be made really small," Howard said.

The filmmakers were also crafty enough to film under the pseudonym "Obelisk," just to get them past a few doors that might otherwise have been closed to them. Of course, many people weren't fooled by the name change once they saw Hanks, Howard and Grazer roaming the streets of Rome trailed by camera crews.

"This is the hardest movie Ron (Howard) has ever shot," Grazer said. "Not only because of being exiled from the Vatican, but because of its darker subject matter."

Joining Hanks is Ewan McGregor as a leading cardinal who may or may not have the best interests of the church at heart, German actor Armin Mueller-Stahl, and acclaimed Israeli actress Ayelet Zurer, as a brilliant and beautiful scientist who deals in particle physics and anti-matter. It's a classic science vs. religion showdown that culminates in a spectacular apocalyptic climax.

To many readers, Angels & Demons was Dan Brown's best work, surpassing even The Da Vinci Code. Like The Da Vinci Code, Angels & Demons has sparked an interest in the landmarks that appear in the book, culminating in a tourism trade that is based on the sites in its pages. What could that mean in terms of visitors? The Rosslyn Chapel, featured prominently in The Da Vinci Code, now draws about 100,000 additional visitors per year.

As for his role in *Angels & Demons*, Tom Hanks recently joked with *Entertainment Tonight* about the upside of playing a guy like Robert Langdon. "Quite frankly, it's really great. It makes me seem smart...he would win *Jeopardy* every time."

Hugh Jackman returns as Wolverine—the fierce fighting machine with healing powers, retractable claws and a primal fury that is a force to be reckoned with.

ALLING all fanboys. Ever wonder how Hugh Jackman's super alter ego came to be?

While Wolverine's origins have been shrouded in mystery, fans of the series and Marvel comic will finally get the answer they've been waiting for when *X-Men Origins: Wolverine* hits the big screen. But that's not all: if hairy chests, steel claws and serious samurai-style fighting strike your fancy, just wait until you see Wolverine fight against his mutant nemesis Sabretooth, played by Liev Schreiber, and Deadpool, played by Canadian star Ryan Reynolds, in the prequel film that reveals how Wolverine came to be the fierce

mutant that he is.

The film explores the early life of Logan/Wolverine's epically violent and romantic past, his complex relationship with Victor Creed (Sabretooth), and the ominous Weapon X program. Along the way, Wolverine encounters many mutants both familiar and new, including surprise appearances by several legends of the X-Men universe whose appearances in the film series have long been anticipated. Who? You'll have to wait and see.

What will be familiar though is Wolverine's complex nature. Through the last *X-Men* trilogy, we've seen Wolverine's strengths and the pain and angst that came along with being

a mutant. But this time, Jackman says Wolverine will be much deeper and darker.

"We are dealing with a character who is probably one of the darker comic book characters ever created," Jackman said of Wolverine to Firstshowing.net. "The movie has a lot of fun elements, but there are layers of pain and darkness to this character. I really wanted to do this spin-off movie because I felt we hadn't truly found who this character was." Added producer Lauren Shuler Donner to Comingsoon.net: "You haven't seen this side of him. It's darker and sadder. But there's a ton of action. It's really kick-ass."

ITH a new film on the horizon, and a fresh new cast, fans will get to see how it all started: how James Kirk became captain of the USS Enterprise, the war with the Romulans, and most importantly how the famous line "Beam me up Scotty" got its start.

At a recent sneak peek at exclusive footage from the film in Toronto, presented by the film's director, J.J. Abrams, fans can expect to see massive explosions, cool action sequences, and most of all, some dynamic character interaction.

*Tribute's* Bonnie Laufer-Krebs recently got the scoop from Zachary Quinto about the film, the cast and what it was like to get in full-on Spock costume mode, ears and all.

#### When you found out you got the role of Spock, were you nervous?

Quinto: I wasn't really nervous because I was so surrounded by people that I trusted. It put me in a position to connect with these amazing minds and the creative energy of these people, to trust that they would take me where I needed to go, Leonard (Nimoy) included. So it didn't really engender in me a sense of anxiety about it so much as it did excitement.

# You're playing Spock at a younger age, which is so cool. What was the feeling you got from fans at Comic-Con?

aboard the USS Enterprise, traveling where no man has gone before.

Quinto: I've been met with tremendous enthusiasm especially now that more and more images from the movie are being shared. There's a real momentum and real excitement that I've experienced. So that's encouraging.

## Your resemblance to an early Spock played by Leonard Nimoy is just amazing!

Quinto: It's pretty remarkable and I've been so blessed to get to know him. There are aspects to him as a person that really resonate for me, and he's been a real inspiration.

#### Do you remember the first thing Nimoy told you when you found out you were going to play Spock?

**Quinto:** Well, we met in an elevator at Comic-Con and he said, "You have no idea what you're in for, kid!"

## Do you recall what it was like when you put the Vulcan ears on for the first time?

Quinto: The first time I put the ears on it was a make-up test so they were working with the material, making sure they were durable enough and appropriately shaped for my face and head. It was a moment of clarity that this wasn't theoretical anymore, that this was actually something that was happening.

#### It must have felt gratifying when you were in full Spock costume.

Quinto: Yeah, definitely. There was this sort of physical transformation that took place over time, before we started shooting, when I had to shave my eyebrows and that really, for me, sort of drew it all together and put me in a physical space to really be available to the character.

# You also worked with an amazing ensemble! What was it like working with Chris Pine, Simon Pegg and John Cho?

Quinto: There's not a weak link in the bunch and everybody has such a great sense of humor. For the most part, we're all going through something for the first time together and that's really nice. The core of us are really sort of being connected through what this means to us and to our lives, which is a really nice thing to be able to share.

Star Trek also stars Ben Cross, Bruce Greenwood, Winona Ryder, Zoe Saldana, Anton Yelchin and Eric Bana.
