Enter Tank (Dane Cook), a professional rebound specialist who, for a fair fee, gets hired by recently dumped men to help them win back their girlfriends. Tank has mastered the skills of seducing—and revolting—women. His elaborate scheme involves taking recently single women on what can only be described as the worst dates of their lives, just to have them happily racing back into the arms of their former flames. But when Tank gets hired by his best friend Dustin (Jason Biggs), he finds himself falling head over heels

But when Joe travels to Thailand, he finds himself in unfamiliar territory, and his life at a crossroad. His target is a top-level politician—an assignment for which he's unprepared—and for the first time, he is beginning to question his career choice. It's all the fault of two people. First, Joe falls for a mysterious


Thai woman (the beautiful Panward Hemmanee) and then he finds he has an affinity for his loyal young mentor, Kong (played by Shahkrit Yamnarm). Originally, Joe plans to kill Kong when his assignment is complete, but the hardened hit man finds his heart is no longer in it.

Based on the 1999 Thai film of the same name, Cage purchased the rights for the film and then proceeded to hire the original creators, twin brothers Danny and Oxide Pang to direct. The transaction was big news in Thailand, since it was the first Thai film to be purchased for the purposes of a Hollywood makeover.

Cage was likely drawn to the stylish, violent flair that the Pang twins brought to the original, especially on a small budget. This time around, the Pangs' canvas is much more elaborate. With a big budget to work with, the action sequences are ratcheted up and the cinematography is spectacular.

Perhaps one of the strangest aspects of shooting was the fact that the Pang brothers (who are identical twins) would trade off directing duties from day to day, something which would often confuse and amuse the cast and crew. "I know a lot of people are amazed, but we do have a strong connection, I guess, as twins," explained Oxide. "There is always one Pang at a time; it helps us save our energy."

That doesn't mean because we were good warriors, let's go off and fight wars, but we should at least acknowledge what our history is."

Kicking off the OMG category of shows for the 18-to-34 crowd is 90210. After an eight-year banishment from our beloved zip code, creator Rob Thomas (who brought us Veronica Mars) transports us back to the halls of West Beverly High. Following in the footsteps of the highly successful Degrassi: The Next Generation, a new class will rule the halls, but BFFs Brenda and Kelly will all revisit the school, if not the renovated Peach Pit (now called, simply, the Pit). You can be sure dating, drama and deception-all the elements of a hit teen show in the making—will ensue.

Meanwhile, on the Upper East Side, Serena and Blair return for another season of shopping, sex and scandals (and a bit of school thrown in for good measure) in *Gossip Girl*, while in *Surviving the Filthy Rich*, a Yale grad finds herself tutoring twin teen billionairesses (surprisingly not played by Mary-Kate and Ashley).

Shifting from the blissfully superficial to the supernatural, much-adored teen show producers Joss Whedon (Buffy) and J.J. Abrams (Felicity, Alias, Lost) each have a new science-fiction show to tout: Whedon brings us **Dollhouse**, a drama revolving around an illegal organization that rents out humans who can be personalized to do any kind of job, while Abrams gives us Fringe, in which a female FBI agent investigates scientific phenomena with the help of an institutionalized genius. Think Mulder and Scully with a dash of cynical (but oh-so-cute) Joshua Jackson. Rounding out the sci-fi category, Jerry Bruckheimer's **Eleventh Hour** features a biophysicist and his flirty FBI counterpart trying to save people from deadly scientific experiments in the U.S. remake of a British miniseries.

Also in the "Something Borrowed" category, a few other new-to-us shows make their North American debut. For the girls, there's *The Ex-List*, an Israeli dramedy adaptation that follows a florist on the hunt for her future husband while *Kath and Kim* redoes an Aussie sitcom featuring SNL-alum Molly Shannon as the mom to Selma Blair. So what if Shannon is only eight years older than Blair; in a world where facelifts are the new Manolos, we don't mind one bit.

For the boys, *Life on Mars* remakes a BBC series in which a present-day LAPD detective mysteriously ends up back in the '70s to fight crime in bellbottoms, unencumbered by cellphones or the need to be politically correct. Joining the retro recall, Kit gets his ride pimped in the return of *Knight Rider*. Completing the roster of anticipated new shows are *My Own*



Worst Enemy, in which Christian Slater plays a suburban dad with a body-double killer and Worst Week, a no-laugh-track required comedy featuring a magazine editor named Sam who tries—and abominably fails—to please the parents of his girlfriend.

He's not the only Sam who'll make us laugh this season; Christina Applegate gets another shot at recovering her memory in *Samantha Who?*, one of the few gems from last year that got picked up for a second season. *Chuck* also gets a second life, which is a good thing given that the titular character is rumored to die twice this year. *Mad Men*—the show that garnered 16 Emmy noms—resumes 15 months from where Season One left off.

Much to our pleasure, everyone is still perfectly coiffed and still seductively smoking in both the boardroom and the bedroom in pitch-perfect attire. Other Emmy nominees Kristin Chenoweth and Lee Pace return to their you-can-look-but-you-can't-touch shenanigans in *Pushing Daisies*. This season they'll be joined by guest stars David Arquette as a horny dude, *er*, Randy Man and *The O.C.*'s Autumn Reeser as a Southern Belle named Kentucky Fritz.

Speaking of guest stars, Lindsay Lohan is set to flip burgers in six episodes of *Ugly Betty*, while we'll finally find out which boy's proposal Betty accepts. That's not the only question we're desperately seeking answers to, especially in shows where the writers' strike shortened some seasons to mere mini-series status. How will **Lost**'s Oceanic Six return to the island? Will Nick George ever discover who killed his father on *Dirty* **Sexy Money**? What new mystery lurks for the **Desperate Housewives** of Wisteria Lane? Will Meredith and McDreamy ever get back together?




the pair remain friends and it's said that Sutherland wanted Roberts to guest star so that the series would go out with a bang (rumors swirl that it's the show's last season).
