


TCOUPLES





Interview



Australian actress Emilie de Ravin has jumped from the *Lost* small screen to the big screen in the upcoming romantic drama *Remember Me* with super hunky co-star Robert Pattinson.

De Ravin recently spoke to *Tribute's* Toni-Marie Ippolito about filming this love story, and what Robert Pattinson is really like to work with.

What did you first think about this love story?

DE RAVIN: I fell in love as soon as I read it. It's one of those few and far between scripts that you read that you're like, "This is just something that I would just kill to be a part of."

I understand there were about 180 women that were up for the part and you got it!

DE RAVIN: It's pretty amazing. Also, they were going in a lot of different directions with the look for Ally to start with and sort of ended up, I think, the furthest from where they started [Laughs]. I'm happy though.

It looks like it's a really intense, emotional story.

DE RAVIN: The premise for the movie is really a romantic tragedy. My character and Rob's character both have dealt with tragedy in our family and our past and we sort of meet unexpectedly,

fall in love unexpectedly, and then the way the circumstances that we meet basically threaten to tear us apart. It's really about just treasuring and appreciating every moment you have with loved ones because you can never go back.

What do you think it is about these romantic tragedies that we just love so much? Th ey're heartwrenching!

DE RAVIN: They are hear twrenching! And for this film specifically I think it's just the reality of this story that people can (relate to), whether or not they've been through something tragic in their life. It's not dealt with in a fluffy movie way, which I think a lot of stories are. It's really gritty and it's very honest, especially with the relationship with Tyler and Ally. You can actually say, "Yeah, I've been like that in a relationship before. That 's kind of how it is." It's all just down-to-earth and real.

There were a lot of paparazzi around while you were filming because of Robert's fame from *Twilight*. How did you guys deal with that?

DE RAVIN: Um, yeah, it took a little getting used to! We really shot the majority of the film on location in Manhattan so there were just people everywhere. It got a little hectic at times! The first day I was so rt of like,

"Oh my God. How am I going to focus?" You feel all these eyes on you and you become very self-conscious about what's going on as opposed to being in your own little world of the character.

What's it like working with Robert Pattinson?

DE RAVIN: He's such a nice, genuine, great guy as a person. And you know that's always nice when you're working with someone you get along with. [He's] very giving. We sort of worked on stuff a lot together and we'd talk about things and really developed our characters together as much as we could. And that's a real give-and-take thing if you've got one person not wanting to do that and one that does—it creates a bit of conflict. But we were both sort of on the same page with everything, which was great.

How do you know things would work out well with the both of you?

DE RAVIN: I guess you don't really know a lot of the time, do you? It's an interesting question because it is something that I think comes more from really just getting along with that person as opposed to sort of someone who really annoys you!



I LOVE ROCK 'N' R

Kristen Stewart and Dakota Fanning talk about starring as real-life '70s rock stars Joan Jett and Cherie Currie in The Runaway s.

risten Stewart ditches vampires for guitars in the upcoming biopic of legendary musician Joan Jett in *The Runaways*.

Co-starring Dakota Fanning as Cherie Currie, *The Runaways*—directed by Floria Sigismondi—tells the story of two friends, Jett and Currie, as they rise from rebellious Southern California kids to legendary rock stars.

What did both of you see in Joan Jett and Cherie Currie that made you want to make this movie?

FANNING: I did it because I really just loved the character of Cherie, and not really knowing about The Runaways. It was just kind of reading the script and that was my introduction. It was really great and I just wanted to be able to play that out and live her life for a little bit.

Kristen, did you see any parallels between you and Joan Jett?

STEWART: Yeah. We have been professionals from a young age, which is hard. The biggest adversities I face are bloggers, and she had people throwing bottles in her face saying, "Sit down you ugly loudmouth." But I think she's really cool. She's really honest. She demands to live her life the way she'd like to. She's just a very smart and inspiring person.

You also did some research with a live band.

FANNING: Floria's [Sigismondi] husband is in a band called The Living Things and I just went to their home studio and sang some of the songs with them to kind of see what it would feel like. You can never really feel what it's going to be like until you're actually filming.

How did you prepare to learn Joan's style?

STEWART: We all had two weeks where we had band practice. They play ed the song that we recorded. I think there were like five or six that we did that we had to have down. It was exhausting, especially with the guitar. I would be exhausted at the end of a rehearsal and she'd (Fanning) be letting out a sigh, and I'm like, "Ah, my shoulders are killing me!" But it was fun. There's an okay amount of footage that you can see them in their performances but they're all sort of fuzzy. But it's just like copying.

Sexuality plays a big part between Joan and Cherie. Was it difficult for you two to recreate?

STEWART: Sure, because nowadays we're like younger kids. I mean, while there was a sexual revolution going on [back then], it's had an effect on us now. So people feel much more comfortable at a young age doing stuff like that but these girls,



they really were the ones to rebel first. It wasn't normal for girls to be sexually aggressive in any way.

How does the responsibility in playing a real-life person compared to a beloved fictional character like Bella from *Twilight*?

STEWART: Bella's effect on the world wasn't as great as Joan's. Obviously, I never got to meet Bella. But when it becomes personal, it becomes my responsibility to not destroy what people are going to take from the most important part of my friend's life. If we hadn't told the story right people wouldn't know who The Runaways were. People in our generation don't know The Runaways. So because they're going to see them through us it's a much different experience than making an original, fictional story.

Dakota, this is a different side of you that we've not seen before. Are you concerned what your fans will think?

FANNING: I'm not nervous because I think the people who are true fans or really enjoy the work that you do will understand the choices that you're making and why you make those choices. I'm getting older now and I want my career, and the movies that I do, to get older with me and I hope that everyone can do that with me.




