

HILARY SWANK

Actress Hilary Swank is supporting "Home 4 the Holidays" to urge people to save animals by adopting them as pets. "I'm so proud to be working with Iams Home 4 the Holidays to help raise awareness about the importance of pet adoption," said Hilary Swank, pet parent and 2009 Iams Home 4 the Holidays Ambassador. "Last year, the program's adoption goal was to get one million pets adopted in just three months, but this year the goal is even bigger: we're on a mission to find loving homes for 1.5 million orphaned pets between Oct. 1 and Jan. 4."

HAYDEN PANETTIERE Hayden Panettiere has long been an advocate for saving dolphins and whales. Recently, the star took part in a campaign to end commercial whaling in international waters by offering up a "swim date" with her and some dolphins, in order to raise money for the cause. Panettiere is so passionate about saving dolphins and whales from slaughter that in 2007 a warrant was issued for her arrest in Japan after she joined in protests against the slaughter of marine mammals in the historic whaling town of Taiji.



MATT DAMON

Matt Damon, who hosted the popular OnexOne charity event in Toronto during the Film Fest, recently merged his H2O Africa charity, aimed at creating widespread public awareness of the water crisis in Africa and gathering support for clean water, with WaterPartners to create a new organization called Water.org—a non-profit focused on bringing access to safe water and sanitation to the developing world. "Every 15 seconds, a child in the developing world dies from water-related disease," Damon has said.

Each year, the Canadian government allows sealers to beat and skin hundreds of thousands of seals. PETA and countless Canadian citizens and a long list of celebrities, including PAMELA ANDERSON and Tricia Helfer, as well as New Moon's Christian Serratos, are calling for a permanent end to this cruel and needless massacre. The European Union's ban on seal products and the U.S. Senate's resolution to end the seal slaughter are major steps in the right direction, but there is still much more to do in order to stop the slaughter forever. 

> obert Downey Jr. brings the legendary detective to life as he has never been portrayed before. Jude Law stars as Holmes' trusted colleague Dr. Watson, a war veteran who is a formidable ally for Sherlock Holmes. Rachel McAdams stars as Irene Adler, the only woman ever to have bested Holmes, and who has maintained a tempestuous relationship with the detective. Mark Strong stars as their mysterious

character as opposed to what some Sherlock Holmes purists might expect? **DOWNEY JR.:** My take is what the Puritans would expect—if the Puritans know what they're talking about, that is. Several of the most surprising things, right off the bat, are that oft-associated props never appeared in the novels or the short stories. He never wore a deerstalker cap, except maybe once for a minute, but even then it was described differently. And even the long pipe is something that [William] Gillette used to not obscure his face onstage. We just went back as much as we could, without wanting to be reverent beyond repair, to how [Arthur

Robert, you have a great way of making your characters feel very natural. Is that what you feel you brought to this character and

DOWNEY JR.: Well, it's never easy to be relaxed. But we work real hard at making it seem that way, and we would write out dialogue to make it seem more natural and have a flow to it. I really think that Doyle was an amazing, amazing writer and storyteller and I didn't really quite know how great he was until we would keep reaching out to find quotes and things that he said or descriptions

It's Victorian England and they're gentlemen. So it's not some of that wavy gravy, free-flowing stuff. It's more boundary-laden, which I think was a great challenge.

Rachel, can you talk about Irene Adler and what it was like wearing your costumes?

McADAMS: She's a really fun character. She's quite different from a lot of women at that time. She's really her own boss, a real free spirit, and she's a woman of the night and of the underworld. So she's very acrobatic and she's traveled all over the world. There's a lot to play with there. And then, yeah, the costumes. I'm such a girlie girl. I was like a paper doll and I was just in heaven, being dressed from the head down.

The costumes are incredible. I mean, real-life corsets with the bones and totally cinched in, and I would try to push my belly out in the morning when they were coming to strap me in. It really was like out of *Gone With The Wind* and I'm holding onto the trailer door and trying to eke out just a little bit of space so that I could speak properly. They managed to squeeze me in every day. They'd try to make me laugh, and on the laugh they'd yank! But it was so much fun to be that authentic and to be really dropped right into the period. It was great.

If we're all here in 2019, talking about films, would you still like to be playing characters like this, Robert?

DOWNEY JR.: Well, I think about rock stars and they always say that they're going to retire by this or that age. Then I think about other guys, who shall remain nameless, one of whom has just starred in a movie with Rachel, who had double franchises going and was like, "God, I'm too old to do it." I think the thing is, if the material is still good and if you still love working with the people that you get to work with, then why not?


I wouldn't want to launch anything else, but I think that *Sherlock Holmes* in particular has just been such a life-changing experience, the act of researching it and making it and producer Joel [Silver] and I getting to do something big together and Lionel [Wigram] and Susan [Downey] and Rachel—and Jude [Law] is so the right arm of this movie. He wanted to go do something undeniably legitimate, and so he's doing *Hamlet* right now. But we, of course, say, *Hamlet*? Anyone can do that. Who gets cast as Watson? He was a huge part of this movie.

So to really answer the question, I'm down for the cause. By then we'll probably have another kid, maybe a Shetland pony, a non-alcoholic vineyard. I might need to really keep cranking them out!

Can you talk a little bit about the love story in this film? Between you and Rachel's character, or perhaps Sherlock and Watson?

DOWNEY JR.: It's called circumstantial homosexuality! I've heard this term is like a staple now, where they say, "We

need a *Butch and Sundance* scene there" or "we need a *Heat* scene there." But we kept talking about *Butch and Sundance*. It means when people are so close that they almost can't stand each other but they can't stand on their own two feet without each other. That's what we really felt.

Doyle was giving us really the first look at what was essentially a two-hander, and Doyle is essentially Watson because he's telling the stories and saying that Watson's telling them. So the process with Jude really was: We met. Joel was like, "Go sell him." So he walks down the hall and my assistant, who never cares about anything, is standing in the hall and she's like, "Oh my God, there he is!" He walks down the hall and he's dressed in that kind of fabulous, super-expensive, underdressed way. I said, "Dude" and literally before he said he was going to do the movie, before he said that he was available, before he said that he either did or didn't want to be courted, we just started talking like two serious actors about what would need to happen to make this work as a piece of straight drama.

I think we just became really close really quick because we just rolled up our sleeves and started working from jump.

What was it like working with Guy Ritchie and his directing style?

DOWNEY JR.: With Rachel McAdams, [on the] first day of shooting, she prepares for six and a half hours, comes to set, there are two long-lens cameras, we did two takes, and I said, "Great. So now we're going to cover it because it's her first shot in the movie." Guy said, "That's all right, old cock. I think we've got it." I was like, "We don't got it," and Rachel's like, "Why did I [even bother getting ready]?"

You look in the movie and it's the scene where I'm looking across the punchbowl (pub) and you see that she winks at me, and he had it. Ritchie knew he had it, and he had it, but sometimes we want to do more, particularly when you get all gussied up for a half-day. You want to feel like you're working there.

ctor Paul Bettany, who plays Charles Darwin in the bio-pic *Creation*, once admitted the idea of working alongside his wife, Jennifer Connelly, alarmed him. "The night before we started filming, we looked at each other and said, 'What are we going to do if the camera rolls and we just start giggling?" Bettany told *The Independent*. "We

are not just husband and wife. We are also parents of children, and you really find out about each other when you do the job of parenting." But the pair quickly proved their chemistry is a scientific fact, onscreen *and* off. "It was the easiest it has ever been, ever, making a film."

Connelly agrees. "I loved it," she told MoviesOnline.ca. "Emma and Charles Darwin were married for many, many years... They grew up together. They knew each other all their lives, so it really suited the material."

The onscreen couple Connelly and Bettany play in *Creation* are not without their troubles. In the film—a provocative true story of Darwin's evolution theory, which had the power to change the world—Darwin and his wife Emma's passion for religion, as well as the ways the couple deal with the death of their daughter, are fraught with true-to-life emotion and the heartbreak of reality.

"This is a real marriage, played by real married people willing to go to places a lot of actors are afraid of," *Creation* director John Amiel told *Tribute*'s Bonnie Laufer. "What Paul and Jennifer brought to the screen was not just experience and extraordinary work ethic...they also brought a willingness to be raw and honest and open. So I never had to worry about creating a marriage; it was there."

Creation is sure to surprise viewers unfamiliar with the side of Darwin's life that goes beyond research experiments and complicated theories about the origins of life. "You know, like most viewers, when I first read a book about Charles Darwin, I thought, 'No thank you, I would rather have my teeth cleaned," says Amiel. But then he read Randall Keynes' Darwin biography, Annie's Box upon which Creation is based. "Suddenly these people leap off the page at you. They're vibrant, funny, enormously emotional, compassionate people."

In the end, says Amiel, it was the

relationship between Darwin and his wife that interested him most. "I became fascinated by the struggle between faith and reason embodied in a loving marriage."

And he's certain he chose the right couple to portray such an important relationship—although it did involve a leap of faith. "I've never cast a married couple before, and had I cast the wrong ones...it could have been disastrous. In this event, it was probably one of the best decisions I ever made."
