eonardo DiCaprio stars in *The Wolf of Wall Street*, based on Jordan Belfort's autobiography of the same name. The story follows the misadventures of Belfort, who started his own brokerage firm, Stratton Oakmont, in his twenties. Although he claims to have formed his company with the best of intentions, he soon became involved in shady dealings, using a trading scheme called the pump and dump.

As his firm grew, Jordan invested in private companies, becoming so powerful that he was able to manipulate stock prices. He once earned \$20 million in under three minutes with the IPO of Steve Madden Shoes.

With so much wealth to spare,

Belfort embraced a ridiculously wild party lifestyle, living a life of unbelievable excess. He became a drug addict, using cocaine and Quaaludes on a daily basis. Drugs were a big expense in his life, but that wasn't all he squandered his fortune on. He owned a 256-foot super yacht, rode in private jets and hired high-priced hookers. The fact that he had a wife and children didn't trouble him a bit.

To prepare for the movie, DiCaprio spent a great deal of time with the infamous Belfort. He told *The Wall Street Journal* that Belfort was "incredibly open about his life, especially the most embarrassing parts. We incorporated a lot of other stories that weren't even in the book into the movie."

Director Martin Scorsese spared no expense for the production. Stratton Oakmont threw a big celebration party every time they reached their monthly quota complete with strippers, marching bands and midgets in Velcro suits to throw at targets, which was recreated for the film. When Belfort mentioned he'd also had a chimpanzee on roller skates who handed out tickets to the stockbrokers, Scorsese went to great lengths to search for a chimp with that particular talent.

> The director also allowed the actors a great deal of freedom when it came to improvisation. "There was more improvising than we'd ever done before," DiCaprio revealed. "This is a generation I understand. I lived through it. I was in New York in the '90s, and I met people like this, and

the music was of my generation. I had an ease for just diving into it and trying to document a certain time period that I very much understood."

In the film, Belfort's immense financial power makes him feel invincible. When he's arrested by the FBI for money laundering and securities fraud, he can't believe that his expansive lifestyle has come to an abrupt halt.

DiCaprio sums up the film's theme this way: "This movie epitomizes the corruption of the American dream, and it's done with a great sense of sadistic humor."

ithin the realm of fantasy fiction literature, J.R.R. Tolkien's *The Hobbit* stands as a classic of the genre. Written as a children's tale about a band of dwarves, a courageous hobbit, a wise wizard and a dangerous dragon, it spawned one of the most revered and popular book franchises of all time with its sequel, *The Lord of the Rings*.

This success has been perpetuated by director Peter Jackson's film franchises, but the process of bringing Middle Earth to the big screen was not initially fruitful.

His early attempts to adapt *The Hobbit* were blocked, as the rights to the novel belonged to other parties, so Jackson instead decided to adapt *The Lord of the Rings*. Three films, Evangeline Lilly makes her debut as Tauriel

17 Academy Awards and 11 years later, *The Hobbit* finally came to the big screen in the form of another trilogy.

The second installment, *The Desolation of Smaug*, continues the story that began in last year's *An Unexpected Journey*, following the journey of Thorin and Company. Traversing the varied terrain of Middle Earth, they confront its countless dangers, including the dragon Smaug who sits upon the treasures of the desolate Erebor—the Kingdom under the Mountain that was home to Thorin Oakenshield and his company of dwarves. Their quest to kill Smaug and reclaim Erebor is met with disapproval from the elves of Mirkwood and the men and women of Laketown.

The Orc chieftain Azog the Defiler provides another obstacle as he seeks revenge on Thorin for cutting off his arm



in battle. The dark evil that persists in the shadow in the form of the Necromancer must also be confronted by the group.

Lord of the Rings alum Orlando Bloom reprises his role as

Legolas. Joining the franchise is newcomer Tauriel, the leader of the Mirkwood Elven Guard, played by Canadian Evangeline Lilly of the TV series *Lost*. Hers will be the first character of Jackson's adaptations not to be based




on a character from Tolkien's books, which was a decision made by the film's writers to instill female energy into a largely male-driven narrative.

Further cast additions include Luke Evans as Bard the Bowman and Stephen Fry as Master of Laketown. Featuring more prominently this time around is Benedict Cumberbatch, who provides the voice and motion-capture for Smaug and the shadowy Necromancer.

The trilogy, which concludes with next year's *The Hobbit: There and Back Again*, adopts the unconventional projecting frame rate of 48 frames-per-second, which was met with some criticism following the release of *An Unexpected Journey*.

The Desolation of Smaug, which will also be projected in conventional 2D, IMAX 3D and other 3D formats, may also receive a mixed response to his use of new technologies, but what is indisputable is the unwavering ability of Peter Jackson to bring Middle Earth to life time and time again.





Check out *Endless Love* on February 14—aka Valentine's Day—a perfect release date for a romantic drama.


